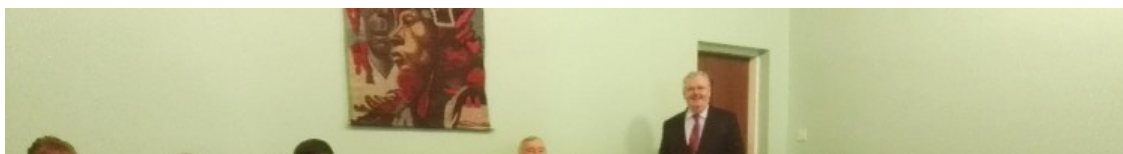
Forming Christ in the Young

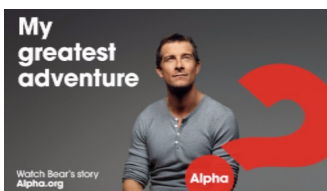
